- b. The response of Jesus to the question—God is the only good one around, and enter life, not eternal life by obeying commands.
 - i. No one can do anything to have a whole life or eternal life.
 - ii. God does it every day for us.
- c. The second question about which ones:
 - i. The social aspect of commandments
 - ii. Plus love your neighbor as yourself
- d. The meaning of perfect:
 - i. To the Greeks it meant virtue—in his mind the man possessed this, an overly spiritualized version of what he was being called to. Very similar in the United States today.
 - ii. To Hebrews it meant completeness in a way that was:
 - 1. Unlimited in love for the other
 - 2. Total obedience to God
 - 3. Total commitment to Christ
- e. Who is this text meant for?
 - i. The wealthiest 1% in the US?
 - ii. The wealthiest 1% globally?
 - iii. For all of us.
- f. What does this text mean?
 - i. We cannot "do" anything to "get" eternal life—God does that for us in Christ.
 - ii. We can sell out to deep discipleship by selling our stuff, giving it to the poor and enemies and follow Christ
