Four Questions from the Doctor
Luke 1:1-38

- i. We are always told to bring our list of questions to the doctor. Today the doctor asks four questions of each of us...
- ii. Church always happens out there. The command to the church community is always to GO...even when Jesus says “come to me” it is in the context of already having activated the GO out there...

In order to GO we have to answer a reluctant *yes* to these four questions...

- I. Do you trust the story? V. 1-4
 - a. Handed down, eyewitnesses, carefully investigated, orderly account.
 - b. So that you might know the certainty of the things you have been taught.

- II. Do you believe God can use ordinary people? V. 5-25
 - a. Zechariah
 - b. Elizabeth
 - c. John
 - d. Mary
 - e. YOU

- III. Are you afraid? V. 26-33
 - a. Zack- startled and gripped with fear.
 - b. Beth- took away her fearful disgrace.
 - c. Mary-greatly troubled—afraid.

- IV. Are you willing to be used by God as you GO? V. 34-38
 - a. Zack- the people knew he had seen a vision.
 - b. Beth-The Lord has done this for me.
 - c. Mary-nothing is impossible with God.

Call to Action:

Can you answer a reluctant YES to these four questions???

Will you answer at least a reluctant yes to these four questions???

Can you say with Mary “May it be to me as you have said??....

IF YES, then you are ready to GO!
