WE CAN ALL BE MARQUEE REALM OF GOD TEAM PLAYERS BY FOLLOWING THESE TWO CRITERIA...

I. CAREFULLY CHOOSE YOUR TEAM (12-19)

- A. Some want new rules to live by, some want to live by ALL of the old rules, some want violent resistance, some want non-violent resistance, some want to support Herod and nationalism unchecked, some want to withdraw to pray and create safe places to hide.
- B. Jesus chooses 12 people who leave “everything behind and follow him.”
- C. The challenge to discipleship in chaotic times is to leave all these labels behind to Follow him—it's what freedom in God's realm looks like.
