A four-point check-up for the church...

I. GENUINE LOVE FLOWS FROM CHRIST—THE BURNING CENTER (12:1-8)

II. GENUINE LOVE IS RADICAL (9-13)

- a. How is the church an alternative from the world of power, privilege, conformity and consumerism?
- b. This passage is not a greeting card slogan but a strong emphasis on discipleship.
- c. Genuine means un-hypocritical and could read "Genuine love is....."
- d. Concrete practice and not abstract words.
- e. It is energetic and profoundly optimistic v. dystopic.
- f. Abhor evil, cling to good v get what you can.
- g. Affectionate to one another in brotherly love v be an influencer.
- h. Outdoing one another in honor v tear folks down.
- i. Not lagging in diligence. Being afire in the Spirit v you do you.
- j. Serving the Lord or the Time? V serving self.
- k. Rejoicing in hope v look back in nostalgia.
- I. Persevering in affliction v run from pain.
- m. Devoted to prayer v manage our way out of it.
- n. Contributing to the needs of the saints, pursuing hospitality vits mine, I worked for it.

III. GENUINE LOVE IS HOSPITABLE (14-18)

- a. Hospitality is THE distinctive mark of the church.
- b. Not just concerned about new people, our people, and mission as charity.
- c. Hospitality as justice.
- d. Hospitality as charity it offers crumbs from the table. Hospitality as justice, offers a place at the table.
- e. Bless, not curse, those who persecute you.
- f. Weep with those who weep.
- g. Forget being haughty or wiser than you are.

- h. Live in peaceable harmony with everyone.
- i. This is an impossible possibility!

IV. GENUINE LOVE IS ROOTED IN KIN-DOM (19-21)

- a. Forget about sticking it to someone or wishing for their downfall.
- b. Feed your enemy and give them water.
- c. Love overcomes a multitude of evil.
